

To embed a Flickr slideshow into a blog...

1. Log in to Flickr

2. Go to 'upload' select (or drag and drop) some photos to upload. The quickest way is to have the folder with the photos in it open on screen, use CTRL-click to multiple select the ones you want and drag them into the browser.

3. Select 'Add to albums' on the left hand side of the screen.

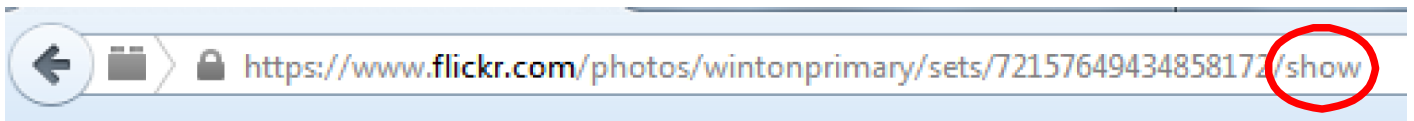
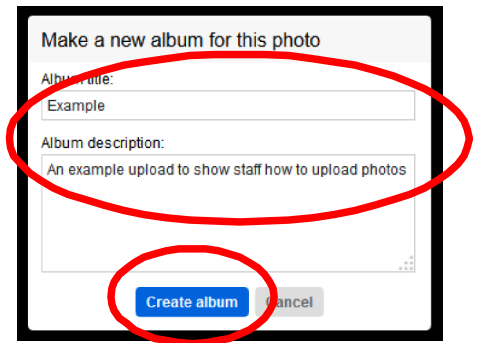
4. Select 'Create a new album' and give it a name and, optionally, a description. Both will be displayed on Flickr so make them make sense.

5. Click 'Done'

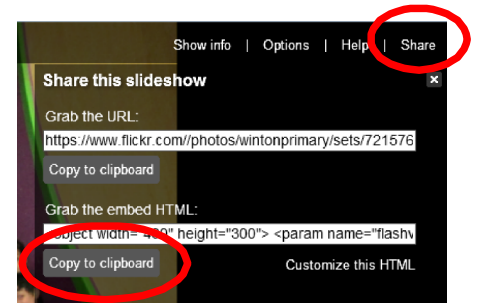
6. Click 'Upload photos' in the top right hand corner of the screen.

7. Once uploaded, click 'Your photostream' on the top left, then the 'Albums' tab.

8. Click on the Album you want to embed and add the word 'show' to the end of the URL, then press 'Enter'.

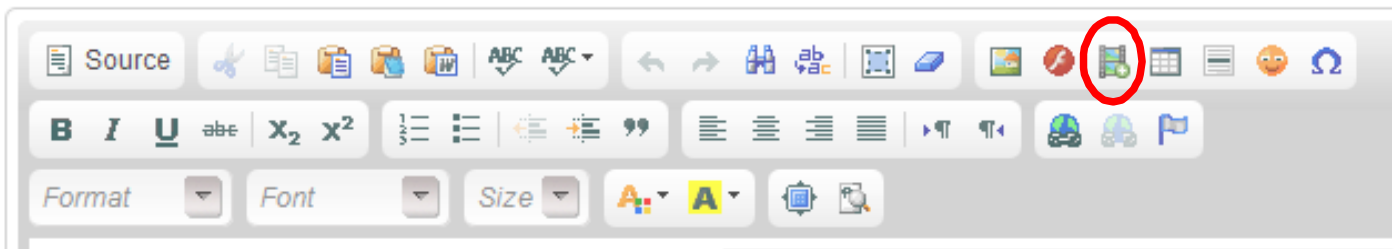


9. Before the slideshow has finished playing, click on 'Share', the bottom 'Copy to clipboard'



10. You have now finished with Flickr. Go back to the article that you were writing on the school website and click in the place where you would like your slideshow to be embedded.

11. Click on the 'film strip' icon...



12. This box will appear. Click in it and press 'CTRL-V', then press 'OK'.

A placeholder will appear in your article. This is where the slideshow will appear.
